## **AT THE SCORING TABLE (2011)**

(This requires a minimum of 3 workers preferably 4)

When the runner brings the cards and place judge forms to the scoring table, the individual who takes these forms (1st worker) will evaluate the place judge forms and determine the order of finish – filling out an Order of Finish Ballot if necessary (see rules of compition sec. 9 C). The places are then written on each card in the **bottom right corner and** circled. If the swimmer is disqualified, write **DQ** in the **bottom right** corner and circle it. Paperclip the cards together in LANE NUMBER **ORDER**, with the place judge forms behind them (unless the place judge forms override time place in which case attach place judge forms to front). The cards are then given to the individual completing the Master Score Sheet(2<sup>nd</sup> worker). This individual records the total points scored for each team in the event on the Master Score Sheet – calculating totals after each event (after Medley Relay, Freestyle, Breaststroke, etc). Then the cards are passed to the computer. Computer operators (3<sup>rd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup> workers) enters the times, Dqs and judges decision if necessary, then staple the cards in lane order as above and file them. After each stroke compare meet manager score with master score sheet and print award labels.
